Handprint Strawberry

What You'll Need:

- Coloured card stock or construction paper
- Glue (or tape)
- Scissors
- A black marker, coloured pencil or crayon

Instructions:

- 1. Begin by using the black marker to trace the shape of your berry onto the coloured card stock. depending on what berry you choose, you can pick whatever colour you like blue, red, purple ... so many choices!
- 2. Next, you are going to take the black marker, and with the help of a grown-up (this part can be a little bit tricky) trace both of your handprints onto a green piece of cardstock paper.
- 3. Using scissors, carefully cut out your berry and handprints.
- 4. The next step is to piece everything together! Begin by laying your berry down on the table, then using glue or tape, attach your two handprints to the top (these should look like two green leaves). Then, using our scrap paper, we are going to cut out a small rectangle from our left-over green construction paper. Glue this to the top of your berry to look like a stem.
- 5. Finally, we are going to take our black marker and add the final details to our berry. This is the part where you can be very creative! You may want to draw seeds on your berry, or you could draw a face or quote ... whatever you want!
